Discussed that some of the PTO money that was used this year, the district should've paid for, such as the paper cutter and the large paper rolls. Fixing the hanging microphones was also brought up again and the name Andy Stefanson was given to contact. Our biggest fundraiser in the Creek Crawl, and now families will be able to donate online. Do we need more incentives to donate? Suggestion made to contact bus company for donating bus time. We need to raise more money, have less expenses, and we need more volunteers.
